

## La Coop Unifrontières Bursary

## <u> Information – criteria - instructions</u>

The Coop Unifrontières donates a bursary to a student pursuing his/her education at the vocational or college level in Agriculture in the Beauharnois-Salaberry region, in Kemptville (Ontario), in St-Hyacinthe or at Macdonald Agricultural College. The amount of this bursary is \$200.

Interested students must write a letter of application with particular emphasis on demonstrating their leadership abilities. The letter must include the following information:

- ✓ Date
- ✓ Name and address
- ✓ Telephone number (home or cell)
- ✓ Age
- ✓ Name of College or Vocational Centre
- $\checkmark$  Type of degree
- ✓ School involvement
- ✓ Community involvement
- ✓ Extra curricular activities (for example, 4H involvement)
- ✓ Involvement in sports
- $\checkmark$  Supply the name and phone number of a contact for references
- ✓ Letter of acceptance in an Agriculture program\*

\*If the applicant has not yet received an answer at the time of submission, he/she must send it by e-mail to the CVR Ed Foundation (go to <u>cvredfoundation.com/contact/</u> to upload and send your document) when received. This bursary will not be awarded without acceptance in the required program.

Place letter(s) in a **sealed** envelope (unfolded and no staples) addressed to: CVR Educational Foundation / Application for Coop Unifrontières Bursary. The envelope can be brought to the Guidance Counselor or to the CVRHS reception desk.

Consult <u>cvredfoundation.com/apply/</u> to find out submission dates and deadline for this bursary  $(2^{nd} round)$ .

The Coordinator of the CVR Educational Foundation will review applications and submit them to La Coop Unifrontières for their consideration.

This bursary is awarded at the graduation ceremonies at the end of the school year.

The one-time payment is released in September when the recipient has confirmed his/her full-time studies at one of the above-mentioned institutions.
