

## **The Mario Dumas Memorial Bursary**

The Mario Dumas Memorial Bursary was established in 2018 to honor Mr. Dumas' unwavering dedication, immense contribution and steadfast commitment to his community including his involvement with youth and CVR High School.

One bursary of \$1000 is awarded to a graduating student who is pursuing post-secondary education. The student has kept an overall average of 70% and over in grade 10 and 11, is involved at school and in the community, has shown leadership skills and is a good ambassador of CVR High School. A good sense of humour would also be recognized. Students apply for this scholarship following the criteria and guidelines set out by the CVR Educational Foundation. Applications are subjected to a blind review by a jury of 3 evaluators.

The \$1000 bursary is awarded at the graduation ceremony at the end of the school year. The CVR Educational Foundation disburses 2 equal installments (September and January) to the recipient, provided he/she confirms full-time attendance in a post-secondary institution.
