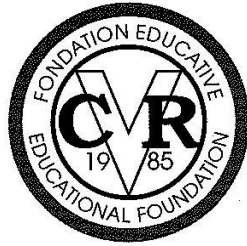
Scoring Criteria

Students should bear in mind the following criteria when preparing their application. Jury members will use these criteria when reviewing and scoring applications. We recommend that students show this document to the people who will be preparing letters of reference.



1. Letter of Intent (10 points)

We have broken down the letter into the components below. If any components are absent from the student's letter, no mark is awarded for that component.

- Does the applicant have clearly defined goals? (Is the chosen post-secondary program clearly mentioned? How will this training lead to a career path?)
- Has the applicant stated what experiences influenced his/her chosen career path? Within this context, the following may be used as examples, if applicable:
 - School life at any level (sports, cultural, leadership, etc.)
 - Community life (working for service groups, sports organizations, churches, agricultural organizations; i.e. 4H, etc.)
 - Part-time and/or summer work experience (clearly explained)
- General presentation. (Did they use proper letter-writing format?)
- At the discretion of the evaluator.



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2. Financial Need Assessment form (20 points)

The applicant must express the need for financial support by completing the Financial Need Assessment form. Extenuating circumstances should be detailed if applicable.

3. One letters of Reference from a CVR educator & one Character Reference Chart completed by a person from outside the school milieu (10 points (5 points each))

- Student's ability as perceived by an educator. (Student's character, academic success and how involvement at school has shaped this applicant; i.e. sports, culture, leadership, etc.)
- Post-secondary potential for academic success
- General work ethic (student's work habits)

- Student's skills, aptitudes and character as perceived by someone outside the school milieu
- At the discretion of the evaluator.
- Character Reference Chart is calculated on 50 points and will be brought back to 5 points on the total score of the student's package

4. Marks (10 points)

The applicant must submit their most recent Achievement Record from the MEES (Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur du Québec) as well as their latest (Term 2) CVR High School report card.
