



Application process for the 2021 COVID-19 bursary

This bursary, sponsored by the office of *Huntingdon MNA, Mme. Claire IsaBelle*, is available to students from the 2021 graduating class.

Every one of us has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, at some level. But for certain families, this pandemic has hit them harder than others, specifically, if we think of our frontline workers. The spirit of this bursary is aimed at giving some students, a little bit of respite, and slightly easing the financial burden of this long-lasting pandemic.

Who is this bursary for ? It is intended for students who have been **directly** impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Applicants must be pursuing post-secondary education.

1. Students who have parents working on the front lines :
 - Hospital staff (any)
 - Long term care / RPA
 - Daycare worker
 - Other essential workers such as:
 - Grocery store staff
 - Pharmacy worker
 - City employee (sanitation, roads, emergency crew, etc.)
 - Any other health care related worker
2. Students whose parents have suffered a job loss, directly caused by the pandemic (ex. : restaurant, entertainment industry and other industries forced to close or reduce their activities due to COVID)
3. Students who have had a parent or other family member lose their life to COVID-19

To apply

1. Write a one-page letter of intent to the CVR Educational Foundation's Board of Directors. Your letter must explain how you and your family have been DIRECTLY affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.
2. Include a proof of acceptance in a post-secondary program (CEGEP, vocational). If you have not received it by the deadline of April 20th, 2021, please email a copy at cvredfoundation@gmail.com as soon as you receive it.
3. Place letter and proof of acceptance in a sealed envelope and bring it to the main office, addressed to: **CVR Educational Foundation Board of Directors/ Application for the COVID-19 bursary**

There are four (4) bursaries of 200 \$ available. The Board of Directors of CVR Educational Foundation will select the recipients by blind review of the applications received. The funds will be disbursed in September, in one installment, after receiving proof of attendance in a post-secondary institution. The recipients will have a maximum of 2 years to claim this bursary, after which time, it will be expired.
