Warren Grapes Agriculture Bursary

<u>Information – criteria –instructions</u>

In 2016 the Quebec Farmers' Association, in collaboration with La Maison de l'UPA, decided to offer the Warren Grapes Agriculture Bursary to a student pursuing his/her education in agriculture (vocational or college level program). The amount of this bursary is \$450.

Interested students must write a letter of application demonstrating their leadership abilities, their relationship to agriculture as well as their good academic standings. The letter must also include the following information:

- ✓ Date
- ✓ Name and address
- ✓ Telephone number (home or cell)
- ✓ Age
- ✓ Name of College or Vocational Centre
- ✓ Type of degree
- ✓ School involvement
- ✓ Community involvement
- ✓ Extra curricular activities (for example, 4H involvement)
- ✓ Involvement in sports
- ✓ Supply the name and phone number of a contact for references

Please, also include;

- ✓ A copy of Term 2 CVRHS report card
- ✓ Letter of acceptance in an Agriculture program*

*If the applicant has not yet received an answer at the time of submission, he/she must send it by e-mail to the CVR Ed Foundation (go to cvredfoundation.com/contact/ to upload and send your document) when received. This bursary will not be awarded without acceptance in the required program.

Place letter(s) in a **sealed** envelope (unfolded and no staples) addressed to: CVR Educational Foundation / Application for the Warren Grapes Bursary. The envelope can be brought to the Guidance Counselor or to the CVRHS reception desk.

The Coordinator of the CVR Educational Foundation will review applications and submit them to the Quebec Farmer's Association for their consideration.

This bursary is awarded at the graduation ceremonies at the end of the school year.

Two equal installments are released (September and January) when the recipient has confirmed his/her full-time studies in a post-secondary Agriculture program.
