



The Ormstown Veterinary Hospital Scholarship

Information – criteria - instructions

The Ormstown Veterinary Hospital (HVO) Scholarship was established in 2021 to encourage a Grade 11 CVR student to further his/her education in veterinary medicine or in animal health technology. The recipients of this scholarship will be expected to spend a day at the Ormstown Veterinary Hospital, shadowing a veterinarian or a technician during the summer. An excellent opportunity to get acquainted with the profession!

Up to two \$750 scholarships will be awarded annually based on academic excellence and a passion for animal health. Students must submit a letter of intent, to the CVR Educational Foundation, concerning their pursuit of their education towards veterinary medicine or animal health technician. In addition to a letter of intent, students must also include a copy of their letter of acceptance in a post-secondary institution. If the applicant has not yet received an answer at the time of submission, he/she must send it by e-mail to the CVR Ed Foundation (go to cvredfoundation.com/contact/ to upload and send your document) when received. This scholarship will not be awarded without acceptance in the required program(s).

Place letter(s) in a **sealed** envelope (unfolded and no staples) addressed to: CVR Educational Foundation / Application for the HVO Scholarship

The envelope can be brought to the Guidance Counselor or to the CVRHS reception desk.

The order of eligibility is:

- 1. One student with plans to pursue his/her education in Veterinary Medicine at the University level.
- 2. One student entering the Animal Health Technology program (3-year CEGEP program)
- 3. Two students entering, either of the above mentioned program

Submission dates and deadlines will be announced by CVR's Guidance Counselor and on cyredfoundation.com/apply/. The applications will be evaluated by HVO administrators.

The scholarships are awarded at the graduation ceremony at the end of the school year.

The funds for the Animal Health Tech program recipient are disbursed by the CVR Educational Foundation in 2 equal installments (September and January) when the recipient provides proof of enrolment and full-time attendance in CEGEP.

In the case of a Veterinary Medicine degree winner, half the funds will be given out upon receiving proof of attendance in a CEGEP Science program and half of the funds will be held for two years and released upon receiving proof of application in the Veterinary Medicine program.
